TUESDAY

MARIAM'S LAW ~ UNDER THE GOLD DOME / THE ROAD TO LEGISLATION

• Representative Stephen Sainz (author of the bill) and Charlotte Spell (Lobbyist for the family) will be discussing the background and efforts made in support of the passage of this legislation.

OFFICE OF SHERIFF LEGISLATIVE CONCERNS

• GSA Executive Director Terry Norris will provide an overview of legislative concerns and initiatives affecting the Office of Sheriff in the upcoming legislative session.

OFFICE OF SHERIFF ACCREDITATION PROGRAM

• GSA Director of Legislative and Governmental Affairs will be providing a status update and implementation progress of the new Office of Sheriff Accreditation Program that is being developed by GSA.

BREAKOUT SESSION ~ BACK TO BASICS PART 1-2

• "Basic Track" for newly appointed SOR personnel responsible for the registration, monitoring, and tracking of registered sex offenders. Attendees may also choose to attend as a refresher of the basics of registration. We will review the checklist for registering a new sex offender, the required registration information and mandated responsibilities of the sheriff's office regarding registered sex offenders.

BETRAYAL: THE PERFECT HUSBAND

• Betrayal: The Perfect Husband is a new ABC News documentary airing on Hulu which tells the story of Jenifer Faison and registered sex offender Spencer Herron and Herron's secret double life. A great teacher and husband on the surface, Herron was a sex addict whose extramarital affairs and sex with students, were hidden for years until one of his students exposed him. Jennifer Faison, a TV producer, will share her experience of betrayal how she came to learn that her husband, high school teacher Spencer Herron, was engaging in several sexual assaults and improper behavior with his teenage students.

NOSE KNOWS – ELECTRONIC STORAGE DETECTION K9'S

• Murray County's Melinda Flood will discuss forensic investigative techniques used to locate hidden devices. This block of training will focus on the history of electronic storage detection (ESD) K9's, how K9 Bear became the pioneer of the program and how K9 Max is carrying on and assisting agencies with locating devices.

• Rescuing Hope founder and author Susan Norris will share the mission of her organization which is enlightening the public about sex trafficking in America, educating potential victims and first responders, and empowering advocates and survivors

DOT COUNTER – TRAFFICKING INITIATIVE

• Edwin "Russell" Thompson, CDL Program Manager of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration will discuss the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) efforts to combat human trafficking by working with public and private sector stakeholders to empower transportation employees and the traveling public to recognize and report possible instances of human trafficking.
